

Lunch To Go Sack

Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Hard

Supplies:

- 1/3 yard of oilcloth
- 2" strip hook and loop tape for closure or spring type clothespin



Directions:

Cut center strip 30" x 8" and two side panels 12 1/2" x 5". Contrasting oilcloth makes a fun look! Fold center piece inside out (making a 5" bottom) notching a 1/4" cut at bottom corners of sides and middle pieces so bag folds easily. Sew in the side panels, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn right side out and top-stitch all around with a little longer than usual stitch. Cut top edges with pinking shears for the "brown bag" look (be careful not to cut into stitching). Fold over top and secure with a clothespin or use hook & loop tape (Velcro) if desired to hold in place. Clean with a quick rinse or sponge. Recycle/Reuse.



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
